

# CPQG Mystery Challenge 2016

## Part Three Instructions

### General Instructions

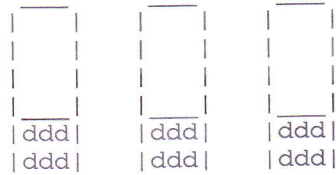
All seams are  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch  
WOF means Width Of Fabric

### For All Versions:

Before starting with Part Three, please complete Part Two having 36 pieces that each measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " with the light fabric being  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

### Scrappy Version:

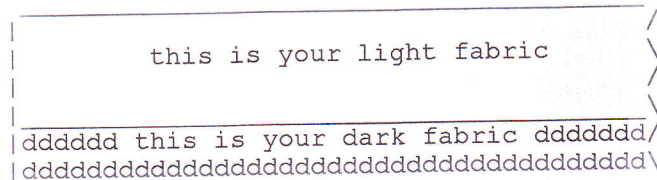
Cut 36 pieces of light fabric measuring  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  
Cut 36 pieces of dark fabric measuring  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  
Sew together one light and one dark piece that measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and you will have 36 pieces



### Two Fabric Version:

Using one-half yard of light fabric, cut  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips WOF  
Using one-quarter yard of dark fabric, cut  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips WOF

Sew the  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips light fabric on top (see illustration below)  
Cut each strip into pieces measuring  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and you again will cut enough for 36 pieces



### Six Fabric Version:

Using the third light and dark fabrics chosen, follow the same instructions for the Two Fabric Version above
