


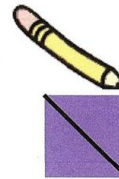


Cutting Your Fabrics for Clue 2

Fabric E - 	Cut 32 strips 2" x 5"
Fabric E - 	Cut 32 strips 2" x 6 3/8"
Fabric F - 	Cut 64 squares, 2" x 2"

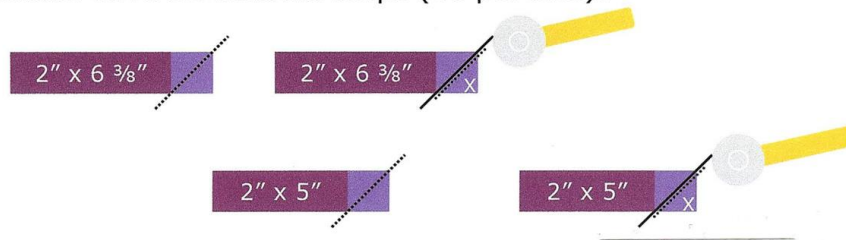
Marking Your Fabrics for Clue 2

Draw a diagonal line with a washable fabric marker or pencil on the wrong side of each of the 64 Fabric F squares, from one corner to the opposite corner.



Piecing Your Fabrics for Clue 2

1) With right sides together, sew the Fabric F squares to the **right** end of **HALF** of your Fabric E strips (both sizes) on the line you drew from corner to corner of the Fabric F square. Cut your squares 1/4" from the seam you sewed and discard the corner fabric, as shown. Press toward the Fabric E strip - should have 32 finished strips (16 per size):
